

## PDFmarks (Mk 2)

This document demonstrates some uses of PDFmarks, and the associated **groff** code shows how to set it up. (Well, this is basically the same document as **pdfmk\_1**; its main function is to be the other half of the double act).

### Simple Note

You can use a PDFmark to attach a Simple Note to a place in a PDF document. To see what is meant, double-click on the “Note” icon to the left.

## 2. Jumping to Another Page

*NEXT* You can use a PDFmark as a sort of URL. This example jumps to the next page with a single mouse click.

### **3. The Beginnings of the Next Page**

[P. 1](#) Here, a single click takes you back to Page 1.

### **4. Jumping to Another PDF Document**

[Mk 1](#) Click on the box at the left to go back to the **Mk 1** document
